

MEETING OF THE ELHN WORKING GROUP COORDINATORS 11 October 2023 online

The meeting starts at 10.00 am

1. Opening/Minutes

Leda opens the meeting and welcomes all the participants. The previous meeting of the General Assembly was held in Gothenburg on 14 April 2023. Eszter Varsa should be added as "present" in the minutes.

2. The ELHN conference 2024 in Uppsala

Silke informs the meeting that she received 42 session proposals by 12 working groups. She didn't receive anything from 8 working groups. Working groups that want to be part of the conference should send in their proposals this week. Silke needs to have the complete programme by next Wednesday in order to be in time to ask for funding. Silke will also apply for funding for commentators, please send commentators names to Silke asap.

Only 1 joint session proposal was sent in. She also received 5 papers by people who are not linked to any working group. A note must be written on the website to make more clear that all proposals should be sent to working groups.

It is depending on funding if food can be provided during the conference. Silke has to pay for the use of the conference rooms. At this moment the Swedish crown currency rate is low, which is in our favour.

Next week Silke will be busy with preparations. After October 25th more information will be sent to the working groups. Every working group will have 4 slots. Working groups can

communicate between them to see if some papers they received could fit in with other groups.

Susan proposes a cross working group session. Silke replies that that is difficult to organize due to the lack of space, an extra plenary session means less space for other sessions.

4 plenaries are needed: Opening, keynote, public event and GA meeting.

Leda, Sara and Manuela like Susan's idea, it could also be a joint book presentation. Silke will think about that idea and asks for a proposal by the end of this week.

Sara Bernard adds that she would like a page on the website with recent publications. Sara Lafuente suggests a book exhibit instead of a plenary session. Silke will look into this idea and contact publishers and ESSHC, the idea also depends on the costs.

Time schedule now is:

Friday October 13th deadline for session proposals

Friday October 20th deadline for sending names of commentators to Silke.

After October 25th Silke informs working groups about the acceptance and numbers of their sessions.

Loose papers will be sent round to see if they can be fitted in with working groups.

To be discussed during the GA meeting in Uppsala is the conference of 2026, please send in your ideas to Silke. There is no funding available to organize a next conference, however the conference fees cover a large part of the conference. This is leaves that the organizers will have to find additional funding themselves.

3. Network

Voting procedure

The nomination committee (Görkem, Tibor and Christian) sent a document about the voting procedures.

Sara asks if the chair must also organize the next conference? It is better to keep that task away from the chair. The network committee works already closely together with the conference organizers.

Do we have a form to nominate someone as chair? No there is no form.

The meeting decides that every working group will send 1 email to Jacqueline with their vote. This must be done 3 weeks prior to the GA when the voting is held. Jacqueline will collect the emails.

Other activities

Donald asks the meeting to inform him about their activities and news so that he can feed the contents on the website.
